

DAY CAMP INFORMATION

- DAYS/TIMES:** Monday - Thursday 9:00 am - 3:00 pm

- FEES:** \$90 per week for 1st Child
\$80 per week for additional siblings in same household
Campers are not registered until all fees are paid.
- FOOD:** Campers are responsible for bringing their own lunch. Please label your camper's lunch box with their name. Also, please include a refillable water bottle for use throughout the day as water fountains are only for filling water bottles. Vending machines are available for all age groups during lunch. Counselors are not responsible for choices made at vending machines. If your child has food & drink restrictions, you may want to pack extra snacks for your child instead. **PLEASE** do not send twenty-dollar bills with your child. We do not have a way to make change for everyone. Vending machine prices are: drinks \$1.25 (cans) to \$2.00 (bottles), Chips, crackers, and candy \$.75 - \$1.50.
- CLOTHING:** Campers should wear comfortable play clothes and tennis shoes. Campers will need a bathing suit, towel, sunscreen & flip flops/crocs to wear to & from the water. Please pack all campers individually as they will not be swimming at the same time and cannot share bags or sunscreen. If your camper is in the 5-7-year-old age group, their sunscreen will be taken up on Monday and placed in a labeled bag to keep at the park for the week. The sunscreen will be returned on Thursday. **Make sure all items fit in a bag or bookbag that can stay with the camper all day and is labeled with the camper's name.**
- DROP OFF & PICK UP:** Drop off and pick up will be handled carline style to avoid having extra people in the building. Morning drop off is from 8:45-9:00. Campers **cannot** be dropped off before 8:45. We will have the area coned off so that no one can park and children can safely exit and enter the car. Campers will then be escorted with their group into the building. Campers cannot exit their vehicles until counselors are present. If a camper arrives late, please escort them into the building and wait in the front lobby for a counselor.
